The Role:

The Full Stack Development Intern will write React.js and Python code to implement high fidelity wireframes, resolve bugs, create new features and otherwise support the site. This includes writing Python, HTML, CSS, in addition to React. Must be comfortable working independently and solving problems on their own. Must be a good cultural fit (friendly, silly and hard working).

Key Responsibilities:

- Implement high fidelity wireframes in React.js and Redux
- Utilize the Django web framework (Python based) to make changes to TMP's site
- Must be comfortable with HTML, CSS, Bootstrap, Javascript, JQuery and Ajax
- Must be comfortable with databases and SQL (Postgres)
- Responsible for QAing code and adhering to coding best practices
- Utilize React to perform DOM manipulations to update the site in real time
- Create the method to send asynchronous updates to the database
- Optimize database queries to minimize load time
- Analyze existing and suggested front end implementations to recommend speed and UI enhancements
- Implement Redux to improve scalability through better state management capabilities

Requirements:

- Strong ability to figure out backend development challenges
- Strong React.js capabilities are a must
- Strong HTML and CSS capabilities are a must
- Must be comfortable with web frameworks (preferably Django and Python)
- Must have some experience with databases (preferably Postgres)
- Must be comfortable with source control (Definitely Git, preferably BitBucket)
- Willing to make jokes and adhere to very silly rules

This position is contingent upon the funding from the Digital Skills for Youth grant. All applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- Post-secondary graduates – can be a program like a coding bootcamp (LHL, etc.)
- Underemployed (employed below their level of education, work part-time or unemployed)
- Between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of the internship

- Canadian citizens, permanent residents or persons granted refugee status in Canada*
- Legally allowed to work according to the relevant provincial and Canadian legislation and regulations
- Available to work up to six months

Cannot be:

- University or college co-op or intern students
- Employees of the hiring employer prior to the start of their internship (does not apply to previous coop students or student interns, although this must be clearly indicated by the employer)
